

# Valentine Glass Blocks



Difficulty Rating- Easy Medium Hard

## Supplies:

For Candy Block:

- 1 - glass block
- 4 bags mints
- 3 yards pink ribbon
- valentine rub-ons or stickers
- 12" floral wire
- hot glue gun

For Rose Pedal Block:

- 1 - glass block
- 1 bag red rose petals
- 1 - "Love" vinyl rub-on
- 3 yards red ribbon
- 12" floral wire
- 1 pkg adhesive rhinestones
- hot glue gun



## Directions:

1. Apply rub-ons or stickers to outside of glass block.
2. Adhere rhinestones or any other embellishments to the outside of the block at this time.
3. Fill block with mints or rose petals depending on your project.
4. Make bow 6 inches wide using 2 yards of ribbon. Secure bow with floral wire.
5. Trim excess wire, so that it is not visible.
6. Use remaining 1 yard of ribbon to wrap around outer edge of glass block. Secure ribbon with a dab of hot glue.

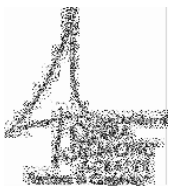
For Rose Pedal Block:

## Directions:

1. Apply rub-ons or stickers to outside of glass block.
2. Adhere rhinestones or any other embellishments to the outside of the block at this time.
3. Fill block with mints or rose petals depending on your project.
4. Make bow 6 inches wide using 2 yards of ribbon. Secure bow with floral wire.
5. Trim excess wire, so that it is not visible.
6. Use remaining 1 yard of ribbon to wrap around outer edge of glass block. Secure ribbon with a dab of hot glue.
